EOC Update: Evacuation Alert For 206 Properties North of Oliver in Electoral Area "C"

The Evacuation Alert issued by the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen Emergency Operations Centre (RDOS EOC) early this morning remains in effect for the properties that may be effected by the Eagle Bluff wildfire. The 42 parcels under Evacuation Alert include 206 properties (residential homes, RV parks, Mobile Home parks and recreational campsites). The effected parcels are listed below.

The RDOS EOC is active and RDOS staff have been working with BC Wildfire Service, Osoyoos Indian Band, RCMP, Oliver/Osoyoos Search and Rescue (SAR) and Penticton SAR to ensure that the residents under Evacuation Alert have been notified.

BC Wildfire Service will continue responding to the Eagle Bluff wildfire 24 hours a day until further notice. Currently there are 100 personnel, several helicopters and water tankers responding to the wildfire. Resources are continually challenged by the steep and rocky terrain in the area and site safety is a priority.

RDOS EOC will remain active to support the BC wildfire's response and will provide updates to the public regarding the evacuation alerts as necessary.

BC Wildfire and the RDOS EOC are actively assessing the situation and should conditions deteriorate, Evacuation Orders may be issued for affected residents.

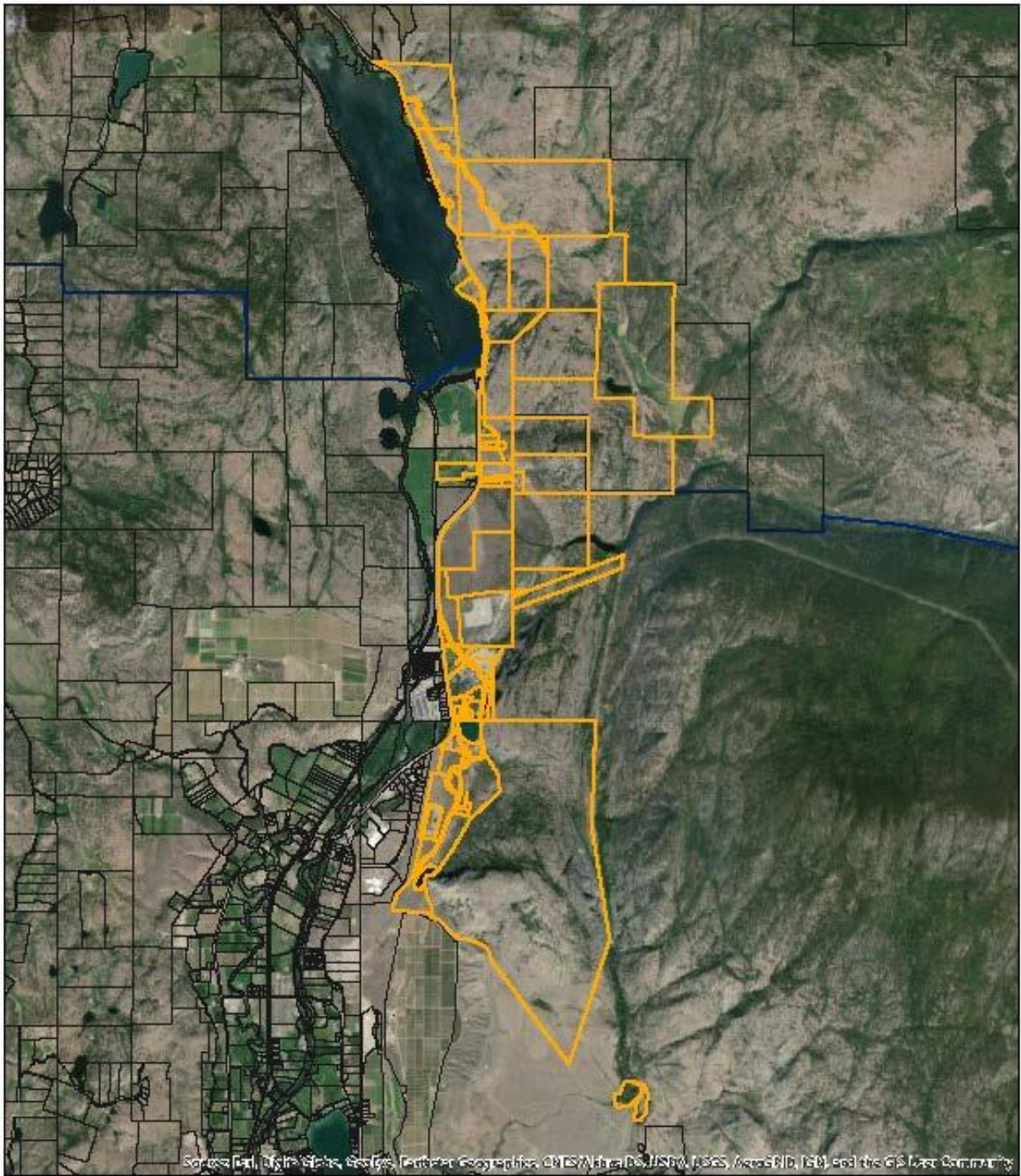

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO WHEN AN EVACUATION ALERT IS IN EFFECT

Upon notification of an ALERT, you should be prepared to leave the area immediately by:

- Locating all family members or co-workers and designate a meeting place outside the evacuation area, should an evacuation be called while separated.
- Gathering essential items such as medications, eyeglasses, valuable papers (i.e. insurance), cell phone charges and immediate care needs for dependents and keepsakes (photographs, etc.). Have these items readily available for quick departure.
- Preparing to move any disabled persons and/or children.
- Moving pets and livestock to a safe area.
- Arranging to transport household members or co-workers in the event of an evacuation order. Affected residents needing transportation assistance from the area can call the RDOS Emergency Operations Centre at 250-490-4225.
- Arranging accommodation for family members if possible. In the event of an evacuation, Reception Centres will be opened if required. Contact 250-490-4225 for information.
- Only **First Responders**, such as Police, Fire, Search and Rescue, or local government staff, will come to doors.
- Monitoring news sources for information on **Evacuation Orders** and locations of Reception Centres.
